There is nothing to ensure that the number the circ clerk enters has anything to do with the number of items that are actually in the package or with the number of items that should be in the package.

We would like to have a column in the item record that shows the number of pieces that should be in the kit and then have a message appear if the clerk enters something different.

We would like the circ stats to increment by not more than the number of pieces that are supposed to be in the kit.

This month we have had 2 cases where the circ stats have been massively skewed by a circ clerk entering a badly incorrect number at the group checkout prompt. One was 10,200 and the other was 6400. We found them with the help of support after the daily circ for the branch was way out of line. When I went looking, I found a number of less dramatic errors, but they are very hard to track because the n\_pieces field is updated every time the circ clerk enters a value in the group checkout prompt box. This incident has made us feel not very confident about the accuracy of our circ statistics.

**Proposal:** Say you want to know the number of checkouts by mobile borrowers, by the number of checkouts by mobile borrowers at route 2 of the bookmobile, and the number of checkouts by mobile borrowers at route 2, stop 7 of the bookmobile.  
 The way to do this with Horizon now would be to assign the borrower to three statistical classes, say ``MB`` (for mobile borrowers), ``MB-R2`` (for mobile borrowers on route 2), and ``MB-R2-S7`` (for mobile borrowers on route 2 at stop 7).  
 So we would like to be able to have statistical classes that are parents/children of other statistical classes. So the MB-R2 stat class would be a subclass of the MB stat class and you'd just have to add the borrower to the MB-R2 statistical class to have their checkouts count for a checkout by a mobile borrower, a checkout by someone on route 2 of the bookmobile, and a checkout by a mobile borrower on route 2. And on the stat reports, there would be subtotals by sub-stat classes.  
 (We need these sub-totals and sub-sub-totals to determine which stops on our bookmobile routes are being used the most/least, and whether they're being used by homebound patrons who couldn't come down to one of our physical branches or by patrons who are just using mobile for the convenience factor. Mobile services are very expensive to provide, so it is crucial to have this level of granularity to maximize their impact with a limited budget.)
