

## New Enhancement Requests Entered As Of Monday, January 1, 2007

**Enhancement#:** 4644 (12/04/2006)

**Subject:** Establish A Default Database Log-in

**Proposal:** Currently when a user logs into Horizon the system remembers the last database login and supplies that same database unless the user changes it. What can happen is a user logs-out and changes to the alternate database (in our case our test database). They finish their work in the test database and log-out. The next time they log-in the system supplies the test database as the database since that was the last database log-in. Now if you are like me, you barely pay any attention to the log-in screen since all you need to provide is your password and 99.999% of the time the database will be correct (our regular database). You then do several hours of work in the test database when something catches your eye and you wonder why something you edited weeks ago is wrong. After a little head-scratching you realize all the work you have done since log-in was done in the test database. You then consider jumping in front of a bus! At a minimum make it possible for the system administrator to establish a default log-in database so that each time a user logs-in they go to the default database unless they specifically change to an alternate database. Ideally a default database should be assignable on an individual user basis, e.g., users 1-50 get database A as their default and users 51-99 get database B as their default.

**Proposal:** The Web Reporter wizard does not include all the fields necessary for a full bibliographic reference, which is needed when the report is to be the basis for student reading lists, or library new book listings. The edition statement is missing, also place of publication (when not entered at Acquisitions stage). The title field is truncated, which also involves losing any volume number and/or part title. These fields can be accessed when using the ``desktop`` expert level of the application, but small libraries do not have either the expertise or the time to create reports at that level. Can all elements of a full Harvard system reference please be available in the basic product?

**Proposal:** At our library we have some marc fields that don`t show by default but are still searched by some of our indexes. It would be nice if HIP would automatically display any marc field that contributed to the search match. For example, if you do a DVD title browse search in our catalog for *\_Long Way Home\_* and choose the first result it appears to incorrectly redirect to the title *\_Raising Victor Vargus\_*. However, this is correct because *\_Long Way Home\_* is an alternate title for this DVD that is listed in the 246 field. Up till this point we haven`t been displaying the 246 field and as a result from the patron perspective it appeared that a weird ``kink`` had occurred in HIP. I wouldn`t expect any revisions to be made in the current HIP version but it would be nice to consider it for IP 8.x
