Pre-Requisites - 1) Familiarity with SD Symphony Configuration/Administration 2) Familiarity with SD Symphony WorkFlows, especially reporting, 3) Familiarity with UNIX for Windows Server operating system 4) Knowledge of the following PERL functions: Variable declaration, String comparison, For each statements, IF statements, Integer comparison, System calls, Arrays, Split.
